

REQUEST MAST REMAINS EVERY MARINE'S RIGHT

CO'S STATEMENT ON REQUEST MAST PROCEDURES:

In accordance with 2DMLGO 1700.2B, MCO 1700.23G, and NAVMC 1700.23, all Marines may directly seek assistance from, or communicate grievances to their commanding officers through the formal process of Request Mast. This includes both the right of the Marine to communicate with the commander, normally in person, and the requirement that the commander consider the matter and personally respond to the Marine requesting mast.

Request Mast provides a Marine the opportunity to communicate not only with his or her immediate commanding officer, but also with any superior commander in the chain of command up to and including the Marine's commanding general.

Marines should always attempt to address grievances first through their immediate chain of command, but this should never supersede their right to Request Mast!
